WAIVER FOR PLAYER & VOLUNTEERS

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

1. IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to participate in any Fuquay Varina Athletic Association activity, I and/or my minor child, our personal representatives, assigns, heirs and next of kin:

2. ACKNOWLEDGE, agree, and represent that I and/or my minor understand the nature of Fuquay-Varina Athletic Association and that I and/or my minor child are qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activity. I further agree that if at any time I believe conditions or equipment to be unsafe, I and /or my minor child will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activity.

3. FULLY UNDERSTAND that: (a) FUQUAY VARINA ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS AND DEATH ("RISKS"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by me and/or my child's own actions, or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW; there may be OTHER RISKS AND SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC LOSSES either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I and/or my minor child incur as a result of my participation in the Activity.

4. HEREBY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, KNOWN AND UNKNOWN, AND ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE LOSSES, COSTS, AND/OR DAMAGES FOLLOWING SUCH INJURY, DISABILITY, PARALYSIS, OR DEATH, EVEN IF CAUSED, IN WHOLE OR IN PART, BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW;

5. HEREBY RELEASE, DISCHARGE, AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE FUQUAY-VARINA ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION, their respective member teams and leagues, their administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers, team members and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the Activity takes place, (each considered one of the "RELEASEES" herein) FROM ALL LIABILITY, CLAIMS, DEMANDS, LOSSES, OR DAMAGES ON MY ACCOUNT CAUSED OR ALLEGED TO BE CAUSED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" OR OTHERWISE, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE RESCUE OPERATIONS; AND I FURTHER AGREE that if, despite this RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT I and/or my minor child, or anyone on my and/or my minor child's behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releasees, I WILL INDEMNIFY, SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS EACH OF THE RELEASEES from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage, or cost which any may incur as the result of such claim.

6. I HAVE READ THIS AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND HAVE SIGNED IT FREELY AND WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT OR ASSURANCE OF ANY NATURE AND INTEND IT TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW AND AGREE THAT IF ANY PORTION OF THIS AGREEMENT IS HELD TO BE INVALID THE BALANCE, NOTWITHSTANDING, SHALL CONTINUE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

PARENTS ARE REQUIRED TO READ, THEN SIGN AND DATE THIS AGREEMENT.

1. I understand that the FVAA is organized to promote youth athletics and good sportsmanship.
2. I understand that my conduct as a parent will have a definite impact on the youth for whom it is intended, the program, and myself.
3. I pledge to support, cooperate, and work in every way to promote youth athletics in the best interest of the programs and youths involved.
4. I pledge to be respectful to all officials, even in an expression of disagreement.
5. I do agree to adhere to the principles of good sportsmanship and to the rules and regulations defined by the FVAA & all other sport affiliations.
6. I understand that if I display poor sportsmanship, whether during or following a game, I will be subject to partial or permanent program suspension. Unsportsmanlike conduct is defined as, but not limited to the following:
 - a. harassment of participants or officials
 - b. use of profane language and / or gestures
 - c. public threats or physical violence
7. Regulations regarding adult's ejection or suspension will follow the guidelines listed below:
 - a. I understand that if I am asked to leave a game, I will be suspended from attending the next game to be played by my son's / daughter's team.
 - b. I understand that if I am asked to leave a second game during any one season, I will not be allowed to attend all the remaining regular season games and the end of season tournament activities.
 - c. I understand that if I am found under the influence of alcohol or drugs while at a FVAA function, I will not be allowed to attend any preseason activities, all regular season activities, and all end-of-season activities that my son's / daughter's team may be involved in. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on FVAA facilities.
 - d. I understand that the FVAA Board will review all adult ejections or suspensions and may extend any suspension beyond what is stated above as deemed appropriate for the offense.
8. I agree that I will support the FVAA regular and post-season All Tournament team coaches' selection process, and I will not participate in, nor encourage any All Tournament player to play on an alternative team unless given prior approval by the FVAA Board. This item does not apply to travel tournament teams.
9. I will not participate in the purchase of uniforms or parts thereof and accept the uniform issued and used by the FVAA. I may, however, purchase white baseball pants, gray softball pants, gray softball shorts, striped baseball socks, cheerleading kick pants, cheerleading competition shoes, soccer shorts and soccer socks. Players names are not to be added to the back of the game jerseys before or during the playing season. **This item does not apply to travel tournament teams.**
10. I understand that **any** suspension may be appealed by using the following process. The suspended individual (parents, guardians of a player) should submit in writing a detailed account of the incident to the appropriate league commissioner within 48 hours of the incident. The statement should give names of any witnesses that observed the incident. The league commissioner then will perform a preliminary investigation and make a recommendation to the appropriate athletic commission.

2012 Spring Recreational Soccer Registration

FVAA Spring Recreational Soccer player registration will continue through to the deadline of **FRIDAY, JANUARY 13, 2012**. To register, participants need to complete the registration form, have one of their parents or guardians sign the liability waiver on the front and the agreement on the back and submit them with the registration fee of \$65.00. (Please make check or money order payable to the FVAA). **After the deadline registrants will be placed on a waiting list and charged a \$10.00 late fee. Late registrants, including returning players, will be assigned to a waiting list and unless an opening is available, will not be allowed to participate this season. If you are a Challenge, PDP, Academy or Classic player please DO NOT complete this form because your coach or team manager has the form that you need.**

All players participating on Fuquay-Varina Soccer Teams MUST be members of the FVAA. Be sure to renew your FVAA Membership or join the FVAA when registering for Soccer. Membership fees are \$65.00 for families outside the city limits and \$40.00 per family inside the city limits.

All new participants are required to furnish a copy of their Birth Certificates at the time of registration.

IMPORTANT INSURANCE INFORMATION

FVAA member participants, coaches, officials, and volunteers are covered by general liability and accident insurance during each sport season at all practices and games scheduled by the FVAA. Additionally, all players and coaches are insured through NCYSA for any accidents that occur during all scheduled FVAA activities.

****Important Note:** The above-proposed formation of the leagues by age breakdown is dependent upon the number of registrants. If necessary, some age groups may be combined in order to allow all players to participate. Some leagues might not form because of lack of participants or coaches and therefore your money would be refunded. **PLEASE NOTE any player wishing to play up one age group MUST submit the request in writing and attach the request to the registration form. I.E. U10 player requesting to play up to U11. Playing down in an age group is prohibited by NCYSA (the governing body over the state.)**

ALL GIRL TEAMS

All girl teams are formed beginning in the U9 age group and continuing up to the U15 age group. If your daughter is **NOT** interested in an all girl team **PLEASE** indicate that by marking the correct box on the registration form. If this box is not marked we will assume that your daughter wishes to play on an all girl team.

PRACTICE / GAMES

Practice is scheduled to begin the second week of February. Practices will be held at Fuquay-Varina locations in the evenings and weekends. FVAA schedules the days and the coach decides the time of your practice.

Games start in March with all ages playing mostly on Saturdays, and with the possibility of some games on Sunday afternoons. All U4 through U8 teams will play their games in Fuquay-Varina. The number of participating teams will determine the number of home games for U9/U10 through U15. Some age groups will participate and travel to games with a few area towns such as . . . Clayton, Holly Springs, etc.

HEAD COACHES

Head coaches are always needed in every age group. Volunteering for this position assures placement of your child on a team. **Be advised that team formation is contingent upon availability of volunteer coaches.** Videos and books are available at the FVAA office to help get you started. We are also working on scheduling coaches' clinics and player clinics before the start of the season and possibly during the season. If you have any doubts or questions concerning coaching youth soccer **PLEASE** do not hesitate to call the FVAA office staff or the FVAA Soccer Commissioner.

UNIFORMS

The FVAA will be providing game T-shirts for all FVAA players. Please check the samples in the FVAA office if you are unsure of the correct size for your child. Game T-shirts are to be kept by the players at the end of the season.

WEATHER INFO

In case of inclement weather, the soccer field condition hotline is 552-5465 x18 or check the field condition information on the website fvaa.org

EQUIPMENT

It is **mandatory** for all players to wear shin guards. Soccer socks must be worn over the shin guards; the team will determine color of socks. Black team shorts are required. These are not provided by the FVAA. Soccer balls vary in size – U4 players up through U8 play with a size 3 ball. U9 players through U12 play with a size 4 soccer ball. U13 players and up will play with a size 5 ball.

REGISTRATION REFUND

The FVAA will issue a refund less a \$15.00 service charge, if a written request to drop is received by FVAA office before February 7, 2012.

TROPHY POLICY

The FVAA will purchase and award individual participation trophies to all participants on the Spring Instructional U4, U5 and U6 teams. Please check with your coach near the completion of the season for distribution times.

END OF SEASON TOURNAMENT

The FVAA will have an end of season tournament for ages U7 and up. The tournament will probably be the last weekend in April or first weekend in May. More information to follow during the season.

SEPARATION OF PARENTS AND PLAYERS

At U7 and up parents will sit on one side of the field and players will sit on the opposite side with coaches. This will be enforced on the FVAA fields and may apply to away games.
